ADULT AND TEEN CHALLENGE/MAUI RELIEF



Teen Challenge of the Hawaiian Islands helps people struggling with addiction become mentally sound, emotionally balanced, socially adjusted, physically well, and spiritually alive here in Hawaii. Through your ROC contributions, we have provided the Oahu men's home with monthly financial support. We have also partnered with the men's home on Maui hosting 16 short term missions teams building Hui Home's & Domes for the New Shelter Maui, providing temporary housing relief funding, medical supplies, meals and prayer for residents of Lahaina and those displaced from the recent fire disaster.

FAMILY PROGRAMS HAWAII EMERGENCY SHELTER



Family Programs Hawaii provides services to prevent children from entering foster care; supports children and families already involved in the foster care system; and assists youth transitioning out of foster care. "Thanks to your continued generosity, on Serve Day the Ho'omalua o Na Kamali'i Emergency Children's Shelter office received a much needed facelift. ONELAU'ENA & ONEMALU HOMELESS SHELTER



221 of residents were served weekly through the Greater Hope Boutique providing 1,429 articles of clothing for men, women, boys and girls. We were also able to touch dozens of children and families through the weekly kids club, men's bible study, garden to table project, weed eaters facility yard care, cool cuts salon and monthly movie nights.

HARVEST FAMILY LIFE MINISTRIES

In 2023, Brad and Esther McDaniel of Harvest Family Life Hawaii and their team served 739 children through CarePortal. Over 1,200 children received school supplies on Oahu, Molokai, Maui and California. We assisted the state with temporary foster care placements: 11 Harvest homes received 26 placements. Adoptions: 4 children were adopted by 2 Harvest homes. Harvest trained 1 new church on children & youth volunteer safety screening.
